Future tense

- Future tense is used
 - for activities that would happen in future

Future tense

- Future tense is formed by adding “endings” of ‘to be’ verb to the verb root and then future marker is attached.

Subject	Verb root	To be verb (in present)	Future marker
Ali	uth uth-na to stand up	ai	ga

These forms of verb 'hona' 'to be' is used to represent the present tense

- The verb agrees with the subject in case of future tense
- Larka aa**ai** ga.
- The boy will come.
- Lar**key** aa**ain** gey.
- The boys will come.
- Lark**i** aa**ai** gi.
- The girl will come.
